- Players enter individual events according to their school year (Year 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and Open).
- Almost all players will need just one day off school.
- **Singles and Doubles** for each school year are held **on the same day**. Playing times are available from this link: **[2019 Schoolboys and Girls Junior Tennis Tournament](#)** Times will be updated online (progressively) as of Monday, 18 November.
- Seeded players do not play in primary rounds: They are placed directly into the Main Draw.
- Players can enter a maximum of 2 Singles and 2 Doubles as well as a Mixed Team Event. Partners **do not** need to be from the same school. They can enter the doubles events and will be allocated a partner if they do not have one.
- A cash prize pool worth \$2,600 for schools and \$500 for open event players will be awarded at the conclusion of the Tournament. Trophies and certificated will also be handed out.

1. How to Enter - What events Players can Enter

- Players individual events according to their school year (Year 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and Open). **Players in Years 3, 4 and 5 will be playing with green low compression balls.**
- Singles and Doubles for each school year are held on the same day. (Playing times will be available at 'tournaments.tennis.com.au' or via the above link)
- Seeded players do not play in the Qualifying rounds: They are placed directly into the Main Draw.
- Players can enter a maximum of 2 Singles and 2 Doubles events as well as in a Mixed Doubles Team. (Boys Team, Girls Team and Mixed Team) Mixed players do not need to be from the same school, players may enter the event individually and will then be paired with another player.

2. Details of Entry and points for Schools

- There are three Primary Team Events (Boys Team, Girls Team and Mixed Team). The teams winning matches proceed and earn points for their school (as in all other singles and doubles).
- Schools are NOT restricted to just one team in each Event. These events are scheduled for Wednesday, 27 November.
- All students may enter a maximum of 2 Singles and 2 Doubles events in their year or a year higher as well as a team event. If two players would like to play double together and are in different year's they would enter into the older players year.
- As players proceed in their events, they earn points for their school. These points (for up to the ten best points scores of each school) are totalled for each school and the Champion School is decided.

3. Trophies and Prizes (Totalling \$2,600 for Schools and \$500 for Open event Winners)

Players Individual winners of the Open events (Boys & Girls) will each receive a \$250 Voucher. There will be trophies for all main draw event winners and runners up as well as a certificate for winner of consolation events.

Schools Trophies are awarded for winners and runners up.
\$800 will be awarded to the winning schools of the Primary and Secondary School team events. The runners up in each of these team events will receive \$500 for their school.
